


Danger Zones

The danger zone around is 12 ft away from the school bus, circling the entire perimeter of the bus. Students should never be in this area because they are not visiable to the driver. If you drop something outside of the bus **DO NOT GO AFTER IT**. Please notify the busdriver immeditely and he/she will retrieve the item.



Red Light Crossing Procedures

The Dehesa School District Transportation routes have been designed in a way that students do not have to cross the street. Red light crossing procedures are only used in the case of an emergency. In the event of an emergency, please follow these procedures:

- Students must stay still at their designated area and wait for the bus driver to secure the bus and activate red light systems, which will stop traffic. The bus driver will then enter the roadway with a hand held stop sign ensuring all traffic has stopped.
- When it is safe the driver will give the student verbal directions to cross the street between the driver and the bus.
- Please walk across the street, enter the bus, and find a seat quickly.
- Please follow the directions of the bus driver at all times.
